



5TMSL Terms & Conditions

By registering for 5TMSL, both the parent/guardian and the player acknowledge and agree to the following terms and conditions. These rules are in place to ensure a fair, organized, and competitive league experience for all participants.

1. Injury & Liability Waiver

Participation in sports involves inherent risks, including but not limited to physical injury, paralysis, and even death. By registering for 5TMSL, parents/guardians expressly acknowledge these risks and fully waive, release, and discharge the league, its organizers, staff, officials, and any associated facilities from any and all claims, liabilities, costs, or damages arising from injuries or other harm sustained during league activities.

- **Assumption of Risk:** Parents and players voluntarily assume all risks associated with participation in 5TMSL, including but not limited to risks of bodily injury, illness, permanent disability, or death.
- **No Liability:** 5TMSL is not responsible for any injuries, medical expenses, or damages sustained by players, spectators, or others. This waiver applies to all injuries, whether caused by negligence, actions of another player, facility conditions, equipment failure, or any other reason.
- **Medical Responsibility:** Parents/guardians accept full financial responsibility for any medical treatment and related costs arising from injuries sustained in league activities.
- **Concussion Protocol:** If a player exhibits signs of a concussion, a league staff member will immediately contact Hatzolah for medical evaluation.
- **Binding Agreement:** By completing registration, parents/guardians confirm that they understand and agree not to hold 5TMSL liable under any circumstances. This waiver is binding and enforceable in all legal jurisdictions.

2. Code of Conduct

All players, coaches, and parents are expected to maintain a high standard of sportsmanship and respect throughout the season.

Players must:

- Show respect for teammates, opponents, coaches, and referees.
- Accept the league's rules and referee decisions.
- Refrain from fighting, taunting, excessive arguing, or unsportsmanlike conduct.

Parents must:

- Lead by example, encouraging good sportsmanship.
- Refrain from arguing with referees or disrupting gameplay.
- Let coaches handle all game-related issues.

Failure to follow these guidelines may result in suspensions or removal from the league without a refund.

3. Payment & Commitment

By registering for 5TMSL, you are committing to full payment and participation for the entire season.

- For now, we are only accepting Zelle, Check, or Cash as payment methods. Payment details will be provided upon registration.
 - By completing registration, the parent/guardian acknowledges that he has read, understands, and agrees to abide by these terms and conditions.

4. Jerseys

- Every player must wear their team jersey to play.
 - If a player arrives without a jersey, the league may have an extra one available. If not, the player will not be allowed to play.

5. Playing Time & Team Assignments

- The league has rules to ensure fair playing time for all players. However, exact playing time may vary from game to game.
 - Playing time rules will be announced in the official rulebooks for each sport. Referees and staff will do their best to look out for it, but it will ultimately be on the coaches to uphold the honor system.
 - Players cannot demand to be on a specific team. Requests may be considered but are not guaranteed. Teams are assigned based on league balance and fairness.
 - The league reserves the right to adjust rosters if necessary to maintain competitive balance.

6. Facility & Venue Conduct Rules

- Players, coaches, and spectators must remain in designated areas.
- The league has access to gyms and fields only - no one is permitted to roam the building or venue.
- Any violation of venue policies may result in suspensions or removal from the league.

7. Rainout Policy

We will make every effort to reschedule games canceled due to rain. However, due to venue availability, scheduling conflicts, and other factors, rescheduling may not always be possible.

- Our goal is to play all outdoor games as scheduled, but in the event of a rainout, participants will be promptly updated on whether the game will be rescheduled.
 - If a game cannot be made up, no refunds will be issued.

8. Refund Policy

- Once a player is registered and the season begins, no refunds will be issued.
 - If a player is removed from the league due to a violation of the terms and conditions, no refund will be issued.
 - No refunds will be issued for games missed due to player absences, rainouts that cannot be rescheduled, or any other uncontrollable circumstances.

9. League Authority

League Officials will have final authority over all league-related matters.

- Referee decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
 - The league reserves the right to modify rules, schedules, or policies as needed to ensure a fair and safe experience for all players.
 - Any disputes or complaints must be handled through the official league communication channels.

10. Media & Content Release

By participating in 5TMSL, parents consent to the league using player photos, videos, and highlights for promotional materials, social media, and league content.

- If a parent does not want their child featured, they must submit a written request to the league before the season starts.
